

Newcrest and ADI supply third shipment of protective equipment to New Ireland PHA

Newcrest Mining in partnership with Australian Doctors International (ADI), has delivered a shipment of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) to the New Ireland Provincial Health Authority (NIPHA) to help New Ireland build its preparedness for COVID-19.

This is the third shipment delivered to the Province under the partnership and provides face shields masks, N-95 masks, disposal masks, protective goggles, gowns and gloves which will be used by the health workers to mitigate the risk of infection.

CEO of NIPHA Dr Wangnapi, received the equipment on behalf of the NIPHA on 6 June. On delivering the equipment, ADI Program Coordinator Ms Devlyn Olan reiterated ADI and Newcrest's ongoing support to the PHA and the province.
